## **Regulations Junior Co-production Market**

### **Feature length film and television projects**

We select up to 30 feature length film and television projects from different countries that already have 10% of their finance secured. For producers and broadcasters, this is the platform to find a co-producer, broadcaster, sales agent, funding body, distributor, financiers, licensing companies etc. For financiers or co-producers, this is the platform to find a new project. Entries can be animation or live-action feature films. Both fiction and non-fiction applications are accepted.

Junior Co-production Market dates: 26 & 27 October 2017

Application deadline: 15 June 2017

Please note: a € 200 handling fee is charged for selected projects.

## **Requirements**

1. The Junior Co-production Market consists of 30 selected projects for children 3-14 years old.
2. The projects must have a minimum of 10% of the financing in place and a participating production company in the country of origin.
3. A draft of the script must be available upon request.
4. Productions need to be submitted via a Junior Co-production Market Entry Form ([cinekid.filmchief.com](http://cinekid.filmchief.com)) before 15 June 2017.
5. All selected projects will be included in the Junior Co-production Market Booklet.
6. We will require the following information in the submission form:

### Project information:

- Logline (max 60 words)
- Synopsis (max 1.500 words)
- Treatment (max 10 A4pages)
- Director's statement (max 1.500 words) (only for film projects)
- If applicable; cross-media strategy
- Still or visual reference

### Film Credits:

- Name and contact details for director, producer and if applicable: writer, co-producer, financier, sales agent
- Director's biography
- Producer's biography
- Streaming link with previous work of the maker

Technical info: Running time, shooting format, languages, type, genre, target audience, planned production date, intended release date

Financial info:

- Total budget (in euro),
- Financing already secured (amount as well as explanatory overview)

7. Cinekid will produce scheduled meetings between the participants and the interested professionals.

8. The producers will have to pitch their project to the industry in a public pitching session, this will last no longer than 5 minutes per project.

9. Cinekid will offer a pitch training session for each project

10. When selected, Cinekid will offer 3 nights at our festival hotel and guest accreditations for a maximum of two project representatives, at least one representative needs to be present for the whole duration of the junior co-production market. Transportation is not included.

11. The submission of an entry implies acceptance of these regulations.
